- AN ACT to amend chapter 15 of the laws of 1998 relating to authorizing the extension of state and local deadlines following a state disaster emergency, in relation to the prerequisites, time and scope thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Chapter 15 of the laws of 1998 relating to authorizing the 2 extension of state and local deadlines following a state disaster emer-3 gency, is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary 5 which relates to the collection of real property taxes, fees, civil 6 fines or other moneys owed to a municipal or district corporation OR SCHOOL DISTRICT, to the imposition of penalties or interest therefor for 7 8 a late payment, or to the filing of an application, report, or other 9 document, form or other paper necessary for the processing of an application or other process to fulfill requirements to qualify for, or meet 10 11 a condition of a government assistance program for persons, businesses 12 or corporations, higher education loans, grants or financial assistance, 13 licenses, registrations or any other programs administered by a munici-14 pal or district corporation OR SCHOOL DISTRICT, during a state disaster emergency as defined by section 20 of the executive law, 15 the governor by executive order issued upon the request of the chief executive 16 may, 17 officer of a municipal or district corporation OR SCHOOL DISTRICT in the affected area, extend the deadline for payment of any such moneys owed 18 19 or for the filing of any such applications, reports, or documents by 20 persons residing or located in such areas OR BY CERTAIN CLASSES OR CATE-GORIES OF PERSONS OR ENTITIES WITHIN THE AFFECTED AREAS, which are due 21 during such state disaster emergency from the date the executive order 22 23 is issued until the date the governor, in consultation with the director 24 of state operations, rescinds the executive order which declared the 25 state disaster emergency; provided that the governor, after consultation with the chief executive officer of the municipal or district corpo-26

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ration OR SCHOOL DISTRICT in the affected area, may extend such deadline 1 2 for a period of up to thirty days by so providing in the executive order 3 declaring that the state disaster emergency has ceased; provided, 4 further, that no interest or penalties shall accrue during such extension period; provided, however, that the governor may order that the extension period provided for in this section shall not be applicable to 5 6 7 certain reporting requirements mandated under state law, the primary purpose of which is to protect the health, safety or general welfare of 8 9 the public from an imminent threat or danger.

10 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any S 11 deadline or date set by state law or regulation for the payment of fees, 12 civil fines or other moneys owed to the state, for the imposition of 13 penalties or interest therefor for a late payment made after such date, 14 or for the filing of an application, report or other document, form or other paper necessary for the processing of an application or other process to fulfill requirements of, qualify for, or meet a condition of 15 16 17 a government assistance program for persons, businesses, municipalities 18 or corporations, higher education loans, grants or financial assistance, 19 licenses, registrations or any other programs, administered by state 20 government agencies, divisions, departments or offices, shall, where 21 such deadline or date occurs during a state disaster emergency as 22 defined by section 20 of the executive law, upon the issuance of an 23 executive order declaring a state disaster emergency, be extended for persons residing or located in the affected areas OR FOR CERTAIN CLASSES 24 25 CATEGORIES OF PERSONS OR ENTITIES WITHIN THE AFFECTED AREAS, for a OR 26 period of time from the date of the executive order declaring a state disaster emergency to the date that the governor, in consultation with 27 28 the director of state operations, rescinds the executive order declaring the state disaster emergency; provided that the governor may extend such 29 deadline for a period of up to thirty days by so providing in the execu-30 tive order declaring that the state disaster emergency has ceased; 31 32 provided, however, that the governor may order that the extension period 33 provided for in this section shall not be applicable to certain report-34 ing requirements mandated under state law, the primary purpose of which 35 is to protect the health, safety or general welfare of the public from 36 an imminent threat or danger.

37 S 3. Where the provisions of this act have been invoked in connection with a state disaster emergency declared by the governor, the state 38 39 shall provide aid to each affected municipal or district corporation OR 40 SCHOOL DISTRICT, whichever is appropriate, to compensate it for the loss interest or other investment income reasonably attributable to the 41 of extension of the period for the payment of moneys; provided, that in no 42 43 shall such aid exceed the moneys that would have been collected case 44 during the extension period or periods declared by the governor pursuant 45 to section one of this act, which shall not exceed thirty days from the 46 date that the governor rescinded the executive order declaring a state 47 disaster emergency, multiplied by an annualized interest rate of six 48 percent. Such aid shall be payable upon the audit and warrant of the 49 comptroller.

50 NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS ONE THROUGH THREE S 4. OF 51 THE GOVERNOR MAY, WHENEVER HE OR SHE DETERMINES THAT A STATE ACT, THIS DISASTER EMERGENCY SO REQUIRES: (1) ISSUE AN EXECUTIVE ORDER EXTENDING A 52 53 DEADLINE IN AN AFFECTED MUNICIPAL OR DISTRICT CORPORATION OR SCHOOL WITHOUT A REQUEST THEREFOR FROM THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF 54 DISTRICT 55 SUCH MUNICIPAL OR DISTRICT CORPORATION OR SCHOOL DISTRICT, (2) DIRECT 56 EXTENSION PERIOD SHALL END ON A DATE CERTAIN, WHICH DATE SHALL THAT AN

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1 BE SPECIFIED IN THE EXECUTIVE ORDER INITIALLY DIRECTING SUCH EXTENSION, 2 PROVIDED THAT THE EXTENSION PERIOD SO GRANTED MAY BE FURTHER EXTENDED BY 3 ONE OR MORE SUBSEQUENT ORDERS, OR (3) ACT IN ACCORDANCE WITH BOTH OF THE 4 FOREGOING PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

5 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to 6 have been in full force and effect on and after January 7, 1998.

7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
