AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the definition of "immediate family"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 6 of section 13-0328 of the environmental 2 conservation law is amended by adding a new paragraph d to read as 3 follows:
- D. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "IMMEDIATE FAMILY" SHALL INCLUDE SPOUSE, SIBLING, PARENT, CHILD, GRANDPARENT, GRANDCHILD, AND, IN ADDITION, ALL PERSONS WHO ARE RELATED BY BLOOD, MARRIAGE OR ADOPTION TO THE PERMIT HOLDER AND DOMICILED IN THE HOUSE OF THE LICENSE OR PERMIT HOLD-8 ER.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 10 it shall have become a law and shall apply only to any license or permit 11 reissued on or after such date.
