AN ACT to amend the town law and the village law, in relation to applications for permits

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The town law is amended by adding a new section 280-b to 2 read as follows:
 - S 280-B. APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS. THE LOCAL LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS IN EFFECT ON THE DATE AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT IS FILED WITH AN AGENCY, SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT AND CONTINUE TO APPLY TO SUCH APPLICATION UNTIL THE FINAL DETERMINATION OF ALL AGENCIES HAVING APPROVAL AUTHORITY AND ANY APPEALS THEREOF. A PERMIT APPLICATION SHALL EXPIRE SIX MONTHS AFTER ITS SUBMISSION OR AFTER A PERMIT IS ISSUED, WHICHEVER SHALL BE SOONER.
- 10 S 2. The village law is amended by adding a new section 7-737 to read 11 as follows:
- 12 S 7-737. APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS. THE LOCAL LAWS, RULES AND REGU-13 LATIONS IN EFFECT ON THE DATE AN APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT IS FILED WITH
- 14 AN AGENCY, SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT AND CONTINUE TO APPLY TO SUCH APPLICA-
- 15 TION UNTIL THE FINAL DETERMINATION OF ALL AGENCIES HAVING APPROVAL
- 16 AUTHORITY AND ANY APPEALS THEREOF. A PERMIT APPLICATION SHALL EXPIRE SIX 17 MONTHS AFTER ITS SUBMISSION OR AFTER A PERMIT IS ISSUED, WHICHEVER SHALL
- 18 BE SOONER.
 19 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
