AN ACT to amend the state administrative procedure act, in relation to providing a procedure for delaying the effective date of proposed agency rules

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 202 of the state administrative procedure act is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 3 10. DELAY. UPON THE VOTE OF TWO-THIRDS OF ITS MEMBERS THE ADMINISTRA-TIVE REGULATIONS REVIEW COMMISSION MAY DELAY THE EFFECTIVE DATE 5 NINETY DAYS BEYOND THAT PERMITTED IN THIS SECTION, UNLESS THE RULE FOR RULE WAS PROMULGATED UNDER SUBDIVISION SIX OF THIS SECTION. 7 PROVISION SHALL BE UTILIZED BY THE COMMISSION ONLY IF FURTHER TIME IS NECESSARY TO STUDY AND EXAMINE THE RULE. NOTICE OF 8 ANEFFECTIVE THAT WAS DELAYED UNDER THIS PROVISION SHALL BE PUBLISHED IN THE NEW YORK 9 10 STATE REGISTER.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
