AN ACT to amend the elder law, in relation to making chemical dependence counseling and referrals available in naturally occurring retirement communities

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 1 of section 209 of the elder  
2     law, as amended by chapter 448 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read  
3     as follows:  
4     (d) "Eligible services" shall mean services including, but not limited  
5     to: case management, care coordination, counseling, health assessment  
6     and monitoring, transportation, socialization activities, home care  
7     facilitation and monitoring, education regarding the signs of elder  
8     abuse and exploitation and available resources for a senior who is a  
9     suspected victim of elder abuse or exploitation, *CHEMICAL DEPENDENCE*  
10    *COUNSELING PROVIDED BY CREDENTIALLED ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUN-*  
11    *SELORS AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH THREE OF SUBDIVISION (D) OF SECTION 19.07*  
12    *OF THE MENTAL HYGIENE LAW AND REFERRALS TO APPROPRIATE CHEMICAL DEPEND-*  
13    *ENCE COUNSELING PROVIDERS*, and other services designed to address the  
14    needs of residents of naturally occurring retirement communities by  
15    helping them extend their independence, improve their quality of life,  
16    and avoid unnecessary hospital and nursing home stays.  
17    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
