AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to fees charged by a theatrical employment agency

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 185 of the general business law is amended by adding a new subdivision 10 to read as follows:
- 10. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, NO FEE MAY BE CHARGED OR COLLECTED BY AN EMPLOYMENT AGENCY NOT LICENSED PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO OF THIS ARTICLE. ANY AGREE-MENT OR CONTRACT WITH AN UNLICENSED EMPLOYMENT AGENCY SHALL RENDER THE AGREEMENT OR CONTRACT VOIDABLE IN ANY ACTION TO COLLECT A FEE, 7 THE
