AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to enacting the "veterinary emergency response and mobility act of 2014"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "veterinary emergency response and mobility act of 2014".

- S 2. Section 6705 of the education law is amended by adding two new subdivisions 14 and 15 to read as follows:
- 14. A VETERINARIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE PROVIDING SERVICES DIRECTLY IN CONNECTION WITH AN INVESTIGATION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF FEDERAL OR STATE ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND/OR ANY RELATED JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS: (A) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO THE VETERINARIAN FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION (B) SUCH LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT INVESTIGATION; AND THE VETERINARIAN POSSESSES SKILLS, TRAINING, OR EXPERIENCE NECESSARY AND RELEVANT TO SUCH INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED INCIDENTS OF ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY. SUCH EXEMPTION SHALL NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE TIME PERI-THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER OD SPECIFIED BY SUCH INVESTIGATION. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE VETERINARIAN OF ANY INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBDIVISION FOR THE PURPOSES OF FACILITATING APPROPRIATE ANIMAL DISEASE MEASURES, IF NECESSARY, PURSUANT TO ARTICLES FIVE AND TWENTY-SIX OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS LAW.
- 15. A VETERINARIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE PROVIDING SERVICES DURING AN EMERGENCY OR NATURAL DISASTER WITHIN THE SCOPE AND LOCATION OF ASSIGNED VETERINARY MEDICAL DUTIES OF THE RESPONSE EFFORTS IF: (A) AN OFFICIAL DECLARATION OF THE DISASTER OR EMERGENCY HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE DELEGATED STATE OFFICIAL; AND (B) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO THE VETERINARIAN FOR A SPECIFIED TIME BY THE AUTHORITY THAT HAS JURISDICTION FOR COORDINATING THE ANIMAL/AGRICULTURAL

1 ISSUES IN THE STATE DURING EMERGENCIES EITHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE 2 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE COMPACT (EMAC).

- S 3. Subdivision 3 of section 6712 of the education law, as amended by chapter 333 of the laws of 1990, is amended and two new subdivisions 4 and 5 are added to read as follows:
- 3. Any student engaging in clinical practice under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian in pursuance of an approved program for the training of veterinary technology[.];
- 4. A TECHNICIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE PROVIDING 9 10 OTHERWISE PERMISSIBLE PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE DIRECTLY IN CONNECTION WITH AN INVESTIGATION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT OF AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF 11 12 FEDERAL OR STATE ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY LAWS, WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND/OR ANY RELATED JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS, 13 14 SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS: (A) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO THE TECHNICIAN FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME BY 15 16 LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER THE INVESTIGATION; AND (B) SUCH LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY DETERMINES THAT THE 17 TECHNICIAN POSSESSES SKILLS, TRAINING, OR EXPERIENCE NECESSARY AND RELEVANT TO SUCH 18 19 INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED INCIDENTS OF ANIMAL FIGHTING OR ANIMAL CRUELTY. SUCH EXEMPTION SHALL NOT EXTEND BEYOND THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED BY THE 20 21 LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY WITH JURISDICTION OVER SUCH INVESTIGATION. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE VETERINARIAN OF ANY INVESTIGATION CONDUCTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION FOR THE PURPOSES OF 23 FACILITATING APPROPRIATE ANIMAL DISEASE CONTROL MEASURES, IF NECESSARY, 24 25 PURSUANT TO ARTICLES FIVE AND TWENTY-SIX OF THE AGRICULTURE AND MARKETS 26

A TECHNICIAN WHO IS LICENSED IN ANOTHER STATE PROVIDING 28 OTHERWISE PERMISSIBLE PURSUANT TO THIS ARTICLE DURING AN EMERGENCY OR NATURAL DISASTER WITHIN THE SCOPE AND LOCATION OF ASSIGNED VETERINARY 29 TECHNICIAN DUTIES OF THE RESPONSE EFFORTS IF: (A) AN OFFICIAL DECLARA-30 TION OF THE DISASTER OR EMERGENCY HAS BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR OR THE 31 32 DELEGATED STATE OFFICIAL; AND (B) AN OFFICIAL INVITATION HAS BEEN EXTENDED TO THE TECHNICIAN FOR A SPECIFIED TIME BY THE AUTHORITY 33 JURISDICTION FOR COORDINATING THE ANIMAL/AGRICULTURAL ISSUES IN THE 34 35 STATE DURING EMERGENCIES EITHER WITHIN OR OUTSIDE THE EMERGENCY MANAGE-MENT ASSISTANCE COMPACT (EMAC). 36
- 37 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
