AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to creating an office of special investigation within the department of law

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 63-e 2 to read as follows:

3 S 63-E. OFFICE OF SPECIAL INVESTIGATION. THERE IS ESTABLISHED WITHIN 4 THE DEPARTMENT OF LAW AN OFFICE OF SPECIAL INVESTIGATION. NOTWITHSTAND-5 ING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, THE OFFICE SHALL INVESTIGATE 6 ANY CASE IN WHICH THE DEATH OF AN UNARMED CIVILIAN IS CAUSED BY A POLICE PERFORMANCE OF HIS OR HER DUTIES. SUCH OFFICE MAY 7 OFFICER DURING THE 8 ALSO BE PETITIONED TO TAKE OVER A CASE UNDER EXTRAORDINARY CIRCUMSTANCES 9 WHEN THE ABOVE CRITERIA ARE NOT EXTENT. PROCEEDINGS OF THE OFFICE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY THE DEPUTY ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR 10 SPECIAL INVESTIGATION, WHO MAY APPEAR IN PERSON OR BY HIS OR HER DEPUTY 11 ASSISTANT BEFORE ANY COURT OR GRAND JURY AND EXERCISE ALL OF THE 12 OR POWERS AND PERFORM ALL OF THE DUTIES WITH RESPECT 13 то SUCH ACTIONS OR PROCEEDINGS WHICH THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY WOULD OTHERWISE BE AUTHORIZED OR 14 REQUIRED TO EXERCISE OR PERFORM. WHERE AN INVESTIGATION REQUIRED UNDER 15 THIS SECTION INVOLVES THE STATE POLICE, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL 16 SHALL APPOINT AN INDEPENDENT SPECIAL PROSECUTOR TO CONDUCT SUCH INVESTIGATION. 17 18 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
