- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the use of environmentally-sensitive cleaning and maintenance products in nursing homes, residential care facilities and adult homes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 2808-e to read as follows:

3 S 2808-E. USE OF ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE 4 PRODUCTS IN NURSING HOMES. 1. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION THE 5 FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL MEAN:

б "NURSING HOME" MEANS A FACILITY PROVIDING THEREIN NURSING CARE TO (A) 7 SICK, INVALID, INFIRM, DISABLED OR CONVALESCENT PERSONS IN ADDITION TO 8 LODGING AND BOARD OR HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THE FOREGOING, AND IN ADDITION THERETO, PROVIDING NURSING 9 CARE AND 10 HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE, OR EITHER OF THEM, TO PERSONS WHO ARE NOT OCCU-11 PANTS OF THE FACILITY.

12 (B) "RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITY" MEANS A NURSING HOME OR A 13 FACILITY PROVIDING HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE.

14 (C) "ADULT HOME" MEANS AN ADULT CARE FACILITY ESTABLISHED AND OPERATED
15 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING LONG-TERM RESIDENTIAL CARE, ROOM, BOARD,
16 HOUSEKEEPING, PERSONAL CARE, (EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY), AND SUPER17 VISION TO FIVE OR MORE ADULTS UNRELATED TO THE OPERATOR.

18 (D) "SENIOR CENTER" MEANS A FACILITY THAT PROVIDES SERVICES TO SENIOR 19 CITIZENS ON A REGULAR BASIS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO MEALS, RECRE-20 ATION AND COUNSELING.

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2. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONERS OF ENVI-1 2 RONMENTAL CONSERVATION AND LABOR, SHALL ESTABLISH AND FROM TIME TO TIME AMEND GUIDELINES AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEAN-3 4 ING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS FOR USE IN NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL 5 HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS AND ADULT HOMES. FOR THE PURPOSE 6 OF DEVELOPING APPROPRIATE CRITERIA FOR SUCH GUIDELINES AND SPECIFICA-7 TIONS, SUCH COMMISSIONERS SHALL REVIEW AND EVALUATE EXISTING RESEARCH 8 REGARDING ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RESEARCH AND GUIDANCE ISSUED BY THE UNITED 9 10 STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE OFFICE OF THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL EXECUTIVE. IN DEVELOPING SUCH GUIDELINES, THE COMMISSION-11 ER SHALL PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT. 12 SUCH GUIDELINES SHALL BE FOLLOWED BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE 13 14 FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES TO IDENTIFY AND PROCURE ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS WHICH ARE 15 16 AVAILABLE IN THE FORM, FUNCTION AND UTILITY GENERALLY USED BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT 17 18 HOMES IN THEIR FACILITIES.

19 3. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DISSEMINATE TO ALL NURSING HOMES, RESIDEN-20 TIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES GUIDELINES 21 AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PURCHASE AND USE OF ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS IN NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH 22 CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES FOR USE IN THEIR FACIL-23 ITIES. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO PREPARE AND DISSEMINATE TO ALL NURS-24 25 ING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES A SAMPLE LIST OF SUCH ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAIN-26 27 TENANCE PRODUCTS THAT MEET THESE GUIDELINES OR SPECIFICATIONS. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE AND GUIDANCE TO NURSING HOMES, 28 RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES IN 29 CARRYING OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION. NURSING HOMES, RESIDEN-30 TIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES SHALL 31 32 FOLLOW SUCH GUIDELINES, SPECIFICATIONS AND SAMPLE LIST WHEN PURCHASING 33 CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS FOR USE IN THEIR FACILITIES.

4. NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS,
35 AND ADULT HOMES SHALL NOTIFY THEIR PERSONNEL OF THE AVAILABILITY OF SUCH

ON OR BEFORE JUNE FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN, THE DEPARTMENT 37 5. SHALL ISSUE A REPORT PROVIDING AN ANALYSIS OF THE IMPACT OF SUCH GUIDE-38 LINES AND SPECIFICATIONS ON THE PURCHASING, PROCUREMENT AND USE OF ENVI-39 40 RONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT 41 NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PRECLUDE NURSING HOMES, RESIDEN-42 HOMES. 6. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL MAINTAIN AND MAKE AVAILABLE A LIST OF
CONTRACTORS WHICH PRODUCE OR MANUFACTURE OR OFFER FOR SALE ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS IN THE FORM, FUNCTION
AND UTILITY GENERALLY USED BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE
FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES.

51 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 52 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law, provided that 53 the commissioner of health is authorized to promulgate any and all rules 54 and regulations and take any other measures necessary to implement the 55 provisions of this act on or before its effective date.
