AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to opioid overdose prevention

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 4 of section 3309 of the public health law are renumbered subdivisions 4 and 5 and a new subdivision 3 is added to read as follows:
 - 3. ANY DISTRIBUTION OF OPIOID ANTAGONISTS THROUGH SUCH PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE AN INFORMATIONAL CARD OR SHEET. THE INFORMATIONAL CARD OR SHEET SHALL INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON:
 - (A) HOW TO RECOGNIZE SYMPTOMS OF AN OPIOID OVERDOSE;

- 8 (B) STEPS TO TAKE, PRIOR TO AND AFTER AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST IS ADMINIS-9 TERED;
- 10 (C) HOW TO ACCESS LOCAL TREATMENT SERVICES UTILIZING EITHER THE OFFICE 11 OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES' WEBSITE OR HELPLINE; AND
 - (D) ANY OTHER INFORMATION DEEMED RELEVANT BY THE COMMISSIONER.
- 13 THE EDUCATIONAL CARD SHALL BE PROVIDED IN LANGUAGES OTHER THAN ENGLISH 14 AS DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY THE COMMISSIONER.
- 15 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 16 it shall have become a law.
