AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring the installation of operable portable fire extinguishers in certain R-3 residential occupancies

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 378 of the executive law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5-d to read as follows:

5-D. STANDARDS FOR FIRE EXTINGUISHERS REQUIRING THAT EVERY R-3 RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCY IN THIS STATE, CONSTRUCTED OR OFFERED FOR SALE AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBDIVISION, SHALL HAVE INSTALLED AN OPERABLE PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHER OF SUCH MANUFACTURE, DESIGN AND STANDARDS AS ARE ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNCIL. FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "R-3 RESIDENTIAL OCCUPANCY" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS DEFINED IN THE NEW YORK STATE UNIFORM FIRE PREVENTION AND BUILDING CODE.
