AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to hunter safety instructors

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 11-0715 of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 2-A. A RESIDENT OF THE STATE WHO HAS BEEN AN INSTRUCTOR OF A HUNTING SAFETY COURSE APPROVED BY THE COMMISSIONER AND WHO HAS COMPLETED HIS OR HER INSTRUCTION RELATIVE TO SUCH COURSE SHALL BE ENTITLED TO RECEIVE A HUNTING LICENSE FREE OF CHARGE FOR THE NEXT LICENSE YEAR BEGINNING AFTER THE DATE WHEN SUCH COURSE OF INSTRUCTION WAS COMPLETED.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
