AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring the instruction of state and local government in elementary and middle schools in the state

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 802-b 2 to read as follows:

3 S 802-B. COURSES OF INSTRUCTION IN STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT. 1. THE4 REGENTS SHALL PRESCRIBE COURSES OF INSTRUCTION IN STATE AND LOCAL 5 MAINTAINED AND FOLLOWED IN ALL OF THE ELEMENTARY AND GOVERNMENT TO BE б MIDDLE SCHOOLS OF THE STATE. THE BOARDS OF EDUCATION AND TRUSTEES OF THE 7 SEVERAL CITIES AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS OF THE STATE SHALL REQUIRE INSTRUC-IN SUCH COURSES, BY THE TEACHERS EMPLOYED IN THE 8 GIVEN TION TO BE 9 SCHOOLS THEREIN. ALL PUPILS ATTENDING SUCH SCHOOLS, IN ELEMENTARY AND 10 MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADES, SHALL ATTEND UPON SUCH INSTRUCTION.

11 2. SIMILAR COURSES OF INSTRUCTION SHALL BE PRESCRIBED AND MAINTAINED IN PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE STATE, AND ALL PUPILS 12 IΝ SUCH SCHOOLS IN GRADES OR CLASSES CORRESPONDING TO THE INSTRUCTION IN THE ELEMENTARY AND 13 14 MIDDLE SCHOOL GRADES OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS SHALL ATTEND UPON SUCH COURS-SUCH COURSES ARE NOT SO ESTABLISHED AND MAINTAINED IN A PRIVATE 15 ES. IF 16 SCHOOL, ATTENDANCE UPON INSTRUCTION IN SUCH SCHOOL SHALL NOT BE DEEMED INSTRUCTION GIVEN TO PUPILS IN THE PUBLIC 17 SUBSTANTIALLY EOUIVALENT TO SCHOOLS OF THE CITY OR DISTRICT IN WHICH SUCH PUPILS RESIDE. 18

19 S 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, provided, however, that 20 any rules or regulations necessary for the timely implementation of this 21 act on its effective date shall be promulgated on or before such date.
