AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including employees of the office of children and family services on the list of public employees for which prevention of duties qualifies as assault in the second degree

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivisions 3 and 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 259 of the laws of 2013, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 With intent to prevent a peace officer, a police officer, prosecu-4 tor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal 5 procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, 7 enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, a firefighter, 8 including a firefighter acting as a paramedic or emergency medical tech-9 nician administering first aid in the course of performance of 10 firefighter, an emergency medical service paramedic or emergency 11 medical service technician, or medical or related personnel in a hospi-12 emergency department, a city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer 13 or traffic enforcement agent, OR EMPLOYEE OF A SECURE OR LIMITED RESIDENTIAL FACILITY LICENSED, CERTIFIED OR OPERATED BY THE OFFICE OF 14 15 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, from performing a lawful duty, 16 including releasing or failing to control an animal under circumstances evincing the actor's intent that the animal obstruct the lawful activity 18 of such peace officer, police officer, prosecutor as defined in subdivi-

With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator or station agent employed by any transit agency, authority or company, public or private, whose operation is authorized by New York state or any of its political subdivisions, a city marshal, a traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforcement agent, New York city sanitation worker, registered nurse or licensed practical nurse OR EMPLOYEE OF A SECURE OR LIMITED SECURE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY LICENSED, CERTIFIED OR OPERATED BY THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, he or she causes physical injury to such train operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator or station agent, city marshal, traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent [or], New York city sanitation work-OR EMPLOYEE OF A SECURE OR LIMITED SECURE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY LICENSED, CERTIFIED OR OPERATED BY THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, while such employee is performing an assigned duty on, or directly related to, the operation of a train or bus, or such city marshal, traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, sanitation enforcement agent [or], New York city sanitation worker, OR EMPLOYEE OF A SECURE OR LIMITED SECURE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY LICENSED, CERTIFIED OR OPERATED BY THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES, is performing an assigned duty.

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
