AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to the time for setting a special election

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 42 of the public officers law, as amended by chapter 4 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows: 3. Upon the failure to elect to any office, except that of governor or lieutenant-governor, at a general or special election, at which such office is authorized to be filled, or upon the death or disqualification a person elected to office before the commencement of his or her 6 7 official term, or upon the occurrence of a vacancy in any office which cannot be filled by appointment for a period extending to or beyond the next general election at which a person may be elected 9 thereto, the governor may in his or her discretion make proclamation of 10 a special election to fill such office, specifying the district or coun-11 ty in which the election is to be held, and the day thereof, which shall 12 be not less than [seventy] FIFTY nor more than [eighty] SIXTY days from 13 the date of the proclamation. 14

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
