AN ACT to amend the executive law and the mental hygiene law, in relation to enacting the "behavioral health services for veterans act"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "behavioral health services for veterans act".

3 S 2. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 369 to read 4 as follows:

5 S 369. BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD. 1. 6 THERE IS HEREBY ESTABLISHED WITHIN THE DIVISION, A BEHAVIORAL HEALTH 7 SERVICES FOR VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD. SUCH BOARD SHALL CONSIST OF NINE 8 THREE OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR, TWO OF WHOM MEMBERS, 9 SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, TWO OF WHOM 10 SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE SENATE AND ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE 11 APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE ASSEMBLY. 12 SUCH MEMBERS SHALL THE PLEASURE OF THE APPOINTING AUTHORITY. VACANCIES ON THE 13 SERVE AT 14 BOARD SHALL BE FILLED IN THE MANNER OF THE ORIGINAL APPOINTMENT. MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SHALL RECEIVE NO COMPENSATION FOR THEIR SERVICES BUT 15 SHALL 16 BE REIMBURSED FOR ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORM-17 ANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.

THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD SHALL
 STUDY AND ANALYZE BOTH THE ADEQUACY OF EXISTING AND THE NEED FOR NEW
 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR VETERANS. IN PROVIDING SUCH ANALYSIS, THE
 BOARD SHALL WORK IN COOPERATION WITH THE DIVISION, THE OFFICE OF ALCO HOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL

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5 S 3. The mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new section 19.43 6 to read as follows:

7 S 19.43 BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR VETERANS.

8 (A) THE OFFICE, IN COOPERATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT AND THE DIVISION OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS, SHALL ESTABLISH WITHIN EVERY COUNTY WITHIN THE STATE, 9 10 ACCESS TO BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES FOR VETERANS. IN ESTABLISHING SUCH THE OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE TREATMENT ON AN INPATIENT, OUTPATIENT 11 ACCESS, 12 AND RESIDENTIAL BASIS, THAT SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, PHAR-MACOTHERAPY FOR ALCOHOL DEPENDENCE, OPIOID DEPENDENCE AND OTHER CHEMICAL 13 14 DEPENDENCE AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDERS.

15 (B) STAFF PROVIDING BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES TO VETERANS SHALL 16 RECEIVE TRAINING IN THE SPECIFIC NEEDS OF VETERANS WITH RESPECT TO CHEM-17 ICAL DEPENDENCIES AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE DISORDERS AND SHALL BE EXPANDED 18 WHEN NEEDED TO ADEQUATELY PROVIDE SUCH SERVICES.

19 (C) IN ADDITION TO THE SERVICES SET FORTH IN SUBDIVISION (A) OF THIS 20 SECTION, THE OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING SERVICES:

21 1. COORDINATION OF SERVICES BY AN INDIVIDUAL CARE COORDINATOR FOR EACH 22 VETERAN WHO SEEKS SERVICES;

23 2. SCREENING AND ASSESSMENT FOR POST TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER, TRAU-24 MATIC BRAIN INJURY, DEPRESSION AND POTENTIAL FOR SUICIDE;

25 3. AGENCY NETWORKING TO PROVIDE VETERANS WITH CONSISTENT TREATMENT 26 THROUGHOUT THE STATE AND THE VETERANS ADMINISTRATION;

4. TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM THE SERVICES PROVIDED BY THIS SECTION;

28 5. EVALUATION OF CLINICAL PRACTICES SPECIFIC TO VETERANS; AND

29 6. COORDINATION OF PATIENT CARE SERVICES.

30 (D) THE OFFICE IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO PROMULGATE RULES31 AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION.

32 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that section two 33 of this act shall take effect April 1, 2014; and provided further that 34 effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule 35 or regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effec-36 tive date is authorized to be made and completed on or before such date.
