AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to information  
provided certified collective bargaining representatives under work  
experience programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 336-c of the social services law,  
2     as amended by section 148 of part B of chapter 436 of the laws of 1997,  
3     is amended to read as follows:  
4     3. The public employer shall publish on a monthly basis a report  
5     summarizing the employer's work experience program for the month. Such  
6     monthly report shall include, at a minimum, summary information regard-  
7     ing the agencies or departments where participants are assigned, work  
8     locations, job duties and assignments, hours worked and period worked  
9     and shall be provided to the certified collective bargaining represen-  
10    tative [and may not be disclosed to any other party]. Such certified  
11    collective bargaining representative shall take reasonable steps to  
12    protect the confidentiality of [such] ANY AND ALL PARTICIPANT IDENTIFY-  
13    ING information and shall take reasonable steps to prevent disclosure of  
14    same to non-authorized persons. Every report provided pursuant to this  
15    section shall contain a warning against re-disclosure and asserting the  
16    confidentiality of the PARTICIPANT IDENTIFYING information therein  
17    provided.  
18    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
