AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to security services in the courts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 21 of section 2.10 of the criminal procedure 2 law is amended by adding a new paragraph g to read as follows:
- G. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (B) OF SUBDIVISION THIRTY-FOUR OF SECTION 1.20 OF THIS CHAPTER, A DEPUTY SHERIFF IN THE FUTURE EMPLOYED BY THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF MONROE COUNTY WHO IS DESIGNATED BY THE SHERIFF TO PERFORM THE DELIVERY OF 7 SERVICES TO THE COURTS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A DEPUTY SHERIFF CURRENTLY OR IN THE FUTURE EMPLOYED BY THESHERIFF'S 9 DEPARTMENT OF MONROE COUNTY WHO IS DESIGNATED BY THE SHERIFF TO PERFORM THE DELIVERY OF SECURITY SERVICES TO THE COURTS SHALL BE 10 ELIGIBLE PARTICIPATE IN THE TWENTY-FIVE YEAR RETIREMENT PLAN SET FORTH IN SECTION 11 EIGHTY-NINE-N OR EIGHTY-NINE-P OF THE RETIREMENT AND SOCIAL SECURITY 12 LAW, AS THE CASE MAY BE, AND SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE PAYMENT OF 13 14 SALARY, WAGES, MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF SUCH DEPUTY SHERIFF'S DUTIES AS SET FORTH IN SECTION TWO HUNDRED 15
- 16 SEVEN-C OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW.
- 17 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 18 have become a law.
