AN ACT to amend the social services law and the mental hygiene law, in relation to reports of abuse or neglect in residential facilities or programs

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivisions 6, 7 and 8 of section 424-c of the social 2 services law are renumbered subdivisions 7, 8 and 9 and a new subdivi-3 sion 6 is added to read as follows:

    6. GIVE TELEPHONE NOTICE AND FORWARD IMMEDIATELY A COPY OF REPORTS
    MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION FOUR HUNDRED TWELVE-A OF THIS TITLE WHICH
    INVOLVE AN ABUSED CHILD IN RESIDENTIAL CARE AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (B),
  - (C) OR (D) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED TWELVE-A OF THIS TITLE TO THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT. A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 9 AGENCY MAY AFFORD THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES AN OPPORTU-10 NITY TO CONDUCT ANY RESULTING INVESTIGATION JOINTLY. THE LOCAL LAW
- 11 ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY REQUEST IN WRITING ADDITIONAL REPORTS, AND SHALL

GIVE TELEPHONE NOTICE AND FORWARD IMMEDIATELY A COPY OF REPORTS MADE PURSUANT TO SECTION FOUR HUNDRED TWELVE-A OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW WHICH INVOLVE AN ABUSED CHILD IN RESIDENTIAL CARE AS DEFINED PARAGRAPH (B), (C) OR (D) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION FOUR HUNDRED 5 TWELVE-A OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW TO THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL LAW A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY AFFORD THE OFFICE 6 ENFORCEMENT. 7 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES AN OPPORTUNITY TO CONDUCT ANY RESULTING 8 INVESTIGATION JOINTLY. THE LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY MAY REQUEST WRITING ADDITIONAL REPORTS, AND SHALL SPECIFY THE KINDS OF ALLEGATIONS 9 10 FOR WHICH NOTICE AND COPIES OF REPORTS SHALL BE REQUIRED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBPARAGRAPH. NOTHING WITHIN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH SHALL PROHIBIT THE 11 OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES FROM CONSULTING WITH LOCAL LAW 12 ENFORCEMENT ON ANY CHILD ABUSE OR MALTREATMENT REPORT; 13 14

This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that the amendments to section 424-c of the social services law made by section one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such section and shall expire and be deemed repealed therewith; and provided, further, that the amendments to section 45.07 of the mental hygiene law made by section two of this act shall not affect the repeal of such section and

shall expire and be deemed repealed therewith. 20

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
