AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to requiring the  
metropolitan transportation authority to establish an expired fare  
transfer policy; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon  
expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new  
2     section 1266-j to read as follows:

3     S 1266-J. EXPIRED FARE TRANSFER POLICY. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER  
4     PROVISION OF LAW, THE AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH AN EXPIRED FARE TRANSFER  
5     POLICY THAT MAY BE AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME. SUCH POLICY SHALL PROVIDE  
6     ANY PERSON WHO PURCHASES A FARE THE ABILITY TO TRANSFER ANY REMAINING  
7     BALANCE FOR TWO YEARS AFTER SUCH FARE IS DEEMED EXPIRED.

8     S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be  
9     deemed repealed on July 1, 2019.
