- AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to restricting placement of level two or level three sex offenders in any temporary emergency housing or homeless shelters used to house families with children

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section 2 131-y to read as follows:

3 S 131-Y. PLACEMENT OF LEVEL TWO OR LEVEL THREE SEX OFFENDERS. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY INCONSISTENT PROVISION OF LAW, NEITHER THE OFFICE OF 4 5 TEMPORARY AND DISABILITY ASSISTANCE, NOR A SOCIAL SERVICES OFFICIAL ACTING ON HIS OR HER OWN OR AS AN AGENT PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE 6 HUNDRED 7 THIRTY-EIGHT-A OF THIS TITLE, SHALL PERMIT OR CAUSE THE PLACEMENT OF ANY 8 BEEN ASSIGNED A LEVEL TWO OR LEVEL THREE DESIG-SEX OFFENDER WHO HAS 9 NATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE SIX-C OF THE CORRECTION LAW, INTO ANY TEMPO-RARY EMERGENCY HOUSING OR HOMELESS SHELTERS USED TO HOUSE FAMILIES WITH 10 11 CHILDREN.

12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 13 it shall have become a law.
