AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the period for the repair of defective equipment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 376-a of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 856 of the laws of 1990, is amended to read as follows:
- Any complaint issued for any violation of section three hundred seventy-five, three hundred seventy-six or three hundred eighty-one of this article relative to required equipment, except a violation described in subdivision two of this section, subdivision forty-seven of 7 section three hundred seventy-five of this article, and except for a violation relating to service brakes, shall be dismissed by the court 9 before which the summons is returnable if the violation as set forth in 10 11 the summons is corrected not later than one-half hour after sunset on the first full business day after the issuance of the summons and proof 12 of such correction as set forth in subdivision five of this section is submitted to the court. For the purposes of this subdivision, "business 13 14 shall mean any calendar day except SATURDAY AND Sunday, or the 15 following business holidays: New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, 16 17 Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans' Day, 18 Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
- 19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
