AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to allowing cities with a population of one million or more to amend point credits on the open competitive fire fighter examination

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 58-a of the civil service law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:

2-A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS LAW OR ANY GENERAL,
SPECIAL OR LOCAL LAW TO THE CONTRARY, CITIES WITH A POPULATION OF ONE
MILLION OR MORE MAY BY LOCAL LAW ESTABLISH A POINT CREDIT ON THE OPEN
COMPETITIVE FIRE FIGHTER EXAMINATION BASED ON APPLICANTS' RESIDENCY IN
SUCH CITY AND TO DETERMINE THE CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR SUCH POINT
CREDIT.

9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
