AN ACT to amend the banking law, in relation to the negotiation of social security checks

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The banking law is amended by adding a new section 6-n to 2 read as follows:

3 S 6-N. NEGOTIATING SOCIAL SECURITY CHECKS. EVERY BANKING ORGANIZATION 4 OR FOREIGN BANKING CORPORATION TRANSACTING BUSINESS IN THIS STATE SHALL CASH PROPERLY ENDORSED SOCIAL SECURITY CHECKS PRESENTED BY THE 5 PAYEE, 6 UPON SUFFICIENT IDENTIFICATION, NOTWITHSTANDING THE FACT THAT SUCH PAYEE 7 DOES NOT MAINTAIN AN ACCOUNT WITH SUCH ORGANIZATION OR CORPORATION, UPON 8 THAT SUCH PAYEE IS SIXTY-TWO YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. PROOF FOR PURPOSES 9 OF THIS SECTION, "SUFFICIENT IDENTIFICATION" SHALL MEAN A PICTURE IDEN-TIFICATION CARD ISSUED TO SUCH PAYEE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHI-10 CLES, A SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OR A BANKING ORGANIZATION WHERE SUCH CHECK 11 IS PRESENTED FOR PAYMENT. 12

13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
