AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of concealment of a human corpse

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Amanda Lynn's 2 Law"
- 3 S 2. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 195.02 to read 4 as follows:
- 5 S 195.02 CONCEALMENT OF A HUMAN CORPSE.
- A PERSON IS GUILTY OF CONCEALMENT OF A HUMAN CORPSE WHEN, ACTING WITH THE BELIEF THAT A HUMAN CORPSE OR A PART THEREOF WILL BE PRODUCED FOR OR USED AS PHYSICAL EVIDENCE IN AN OFFICIAL PROCEEDING OR PROSPECTIVE OFFI-9 CIAL PROCEEDING, SUCH PERSON, ALONE OR IN CONCERT WITH ANOTHER,
- 10 CONCEALS, ALTERS OR DESTROYS SUCH CORPSE OR PART THEREOF WITH THE INTENT
- 11 TO PREVENT ITS PRODUCTION, USE OR DISCOVERY.
- 12 CONCEALMENT OF A HUMAN CORPSE IS A CLASS E FELONY.
- 13 S 3. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
