- AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the use of environmentally-sensitive cleaning and maintenance products in nursing homes, residential care facilities and adult homes

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 2808-e to read as follows:

3 S 2808-E. USE OF ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE 4 PRODUCTS IN NURSING HOMES. 1. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION THE 5 FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL MEAN:

6 (A) "NURSING HOME" MEANS A FACILITY PROVIDING THEREIN NURSING CARE TO 7 SICK, INVALID, INFIRM, DISABLED OR CONVALESCENT PERSONS IN ADDITION TO 8 LODGING AND BOARD OR HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE, OR ANY COMBINATION OF THE 9 FOREGOING, AND IN ADDITION THERETO, PROVIDING NURSING CARE AND 10 HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE, OR EITHER OF THEM, TO PERSONS WHO ARE NOT OCCU-11 PANTS OF THE FACILITY.

12 (B) "RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITY" MEANS A NURSING HOME OR A 13 FACILITY PROVIDING HEALTH-RELATED SERVICE.

14 (C) "ADULT HOME" MEANS AN ADULT CARE FACILITY ESTABLISHED AND OPERATED 15 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING LONG-TERM RESIDENTIAL CARE, ROOM, BOARD, 16 HOUSEKEEPING, PERSONAL CARE, (EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY), AND SUPER-17 VISION TO FIVE OR MORE ADULTS UNRELATED TO THE OPERATOR.

18 (D) "SENIOR CENTER" MEANS A FACILITY THAT PROVIDES SERVICES TO SENIOR 19 CITIZENS ON A REGULAR BASIS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO MEALS, RECRE-20 ATION AND COUNSELING.

21 2. THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMISSIONERS OF ENVI-22 RONMENTAL CONSERVATION AND LABOR, SHALL ESTABLISH AND FROM TIME TO TIME

AMEND GUIDELINES AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEAN-1 2 ING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS FOR USE IN NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL 3 HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS AND ADULT HOMES. FOR THE PURPOSE DEVELOPING APPROPRIATE CRITERIA FOR SUCH GUIDELINES AND SPECIFICA-4 OF 5 TIONS, SUCH COMMISSIONERS SHALL REVIEW AND EVALUATE EXISTING RESEARCH 6 REGARDING ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS, 7 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RESEARCH AND GUIDANCE ISSUED BY THE UNITED 8 STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND THE OFFICE OF THE FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL EXECUTIVE. IN DEVELOPING SUCH GUIDELINES, THE COMMISSION-9 10 SHALL PROVIDE PUBLIC NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT. SUCH ER GUIDELINES SHALL BE FOLLOWED BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH 11 CARE 12 FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES TO IDENTIFY AND PROCURE ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS 13 WHICH ARE 14 AVAILABLE IN THE FORM, FUNCTION AND UTILITY GENERALLY USED BY NURSING 15 HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT 16 HOMES IN THEIR FACILITIES.

17 THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DISSEMINATE TO ALL NURSING HOMES, RESIDEN-3. TIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES GUIDELINES 18 19 AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE PURCHASE AND USE OF ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE 20 CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS IN NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH 21 CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES FOR USE IN THEIR FACIL-22 ITIES. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ALSO PREPARE AND DISSEMINATE TO ALL NURS-ING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT 23 HOMES A SAMPLE LIST OF SUCH ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAIN-24 25 TENANCE PRODUCTS THAT MEET THESE GUIDELINES OR SPECIFICATIONS. THE 26 COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE ASSISTANCE AND GUIDANCE TO NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES IN 27 CARRYING OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION. NURSING HOMES, 28 RESIDEN-29 TIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES SHALL 30 FOLLOW SUCH GUIDELINES, SPECIFICATIONS AND SAMPLE LIST WHEN PURCHASING CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS FOR USE IN THEIR FACILITIES. 31

4. NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS,
AND ADULT HOMES SHALL NOTIFY THEIR PERSONNEL OF THE AVAILABILITY OF SUCH
GUIDELINES, SPECIFICATIONS AND SAMPLE LIST.

5. ON OR BEFORE JUNE FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 35 ISSUE A REPORT PROVIDING AN ANALYSIS OF THE IMPACT OF SUCH GUIDELINES 36 AND SPECIFICATIONS ON THE PURCHASING, PROCUREMENT AND USE OF ENVIRONMEN-37 38 TALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT 39 HOMES. 40 NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL PRECLUDE NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES FROM DEPLETING EXISTING 41 CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE SUPPLY STORES PURCHASED PRIOR TO THE EFFECTIVE 42 43 DATE OF THIS SECTION.

6. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL MAINTAIN AND MAKE AVAILABLE A LIST OF
CONTRACTORS WHICH PRODUCE OR MANUFACTURE OR OFFER FOR SALE ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE PRODUCTS IN THE FORM, FUNCTION
AND UTILITY GENERALLY USED BY NURSING HOMES, RESIDENTIAL HEALTH CARE
FACILITIES, SENIOR CENTERS, AND ADULT HOMES.

49 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 50 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law, provided that 51 the commissioner of health is authorized to promulgate any and all rules 52 and regulations and take any other measures necessary to implement the 53 provisions of this act on or before its effective date.
