AN ACT to amend the New York state urban development corporation act, in relation to providing science, technology, engineering and mathematics grants for the encouragement of women and minorities to pursue careers in technology

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 16-m of section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, constituting the New York state urban development corporation act, is amended by adding a new subdivision (o) to read as follows:

- (O) ASSISTANCE TO ENCOURAGE WOMEN AND MINORITIES TO PURSUE SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS BY PROVIDING CAREERS (STEM) GRANTS, ON A COMPETITIVE BASIS, TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS OR BOARDS COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES FOR USE IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS, SHALL NOT INCLUDE SCHOOLS DESIGNATED UNDER ARTICLE FIFTY-SIX OF EDUCATION LAW, TO DEVELOP NEW AND ENHANCE CURRENT STEM PROGRAMS IN GRADES SIX THROUGH TWELVE, INCLUDING CAREER EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES, AND PARTNERSHIPS WITH OPPORTUNITIES FOR TECHNICAL SKILLS ATTAINMENT POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS.
- 13 (I) DEVELOPMENT OF PROPOSALS AND SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS OF SUCH STEM 14 GRANTS SHALL BE CARRIED OUT IN COOPERATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF THE 15 STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.
- 16 (II) GRANTS SHALL BE MADE FOR A RECURRENT PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS AT 17 WHICH TIME THE CHAIRPERSON SHALL EVALUATE THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE STEM 18 GRANTS BASED ON CRITERIA DEVELOPED IN COOPERATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER 19 OF THE STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.
- 20 (1) SUCH CRITERIA SHALL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, THE NUMBER OF 21 WOMEN AND MINORITY STUDENTS IN STEM PROGRAMS BEFORE AND AFTER THE GRANT 22 PERIOD; AND

(2) THE PERCENTAGE OF THE NEW STEM STUDENTS WHO HAVE GONE ON TO TWO-AND FOUR-YEAR POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS AND THE PERCENTAGE WHO HAVE BEEN EMPLOYED FOR A PERIOD NOT LESS THAN TWO YEARS IN MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, HEALTH RELATED FIELDS AND THE LICENSED PROFESSIONS.

- (III) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION LOCAL EDUCATION AGENCIES SHALL MEAN SCHOOL DISTRICTS, BOARDS OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES BUT SHALL NOT INCLUDE SCHOOLS DESIGNATED UNDER ARTICLE FIFTY-SIX OF THE EDUCATION LAW.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the amend-11 ments to section 16-m of section 1 of chapter 174 of the laws of 1968, 12 constituting the New York state urban development corporation act, made 13 by section one of this act, shall not affect the expiration of such 14 section and shall be deemed to expire therewith.
