- AN ACT to amend chapter 719 of the laws of 1982, relating to authorizing the commissioner of general services to convey certain state lands in the county of Suffolk to the town of Islip, in relation to exceptions for certain property

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Chapter 719 of the laws of 1982, relating to authorizing 2 the commissioner of general services to convey certain state lands in 3 the county of Suffolk to the town of Islip, is amended by adding a new 4 section 1-a to read as follows:

5 1-A. THE NEW YORK INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL AND S CONVEY TO THE TOWN OF ISLIP, SUFFOLK COUNTY, THE LAND AND IMPROVEMENTS 6 THEREON, DESCRIBED IN SECTION SEVEN-A OF THIS ACT. CONVEYANCE OF SUCH 7 8 LAND SHALL BE UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS, INCLUDING CONSIDERATION, NEW YORK INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY AND THE TOWN OF ISLIP MAY FIX 9 AS THE 10 AND DETERMINE.

11 S 2. The opening paragraph of section 7 of chapter 719 of the laws of 12 1982, relating to authorizing the commissioner of general services to 13 convey certain state lands in the county of Suffolk to the town of 14 Islip, as amended by chapter 269 of the laws of 2001, is amended and 15 three new sections 7-a, 7-b and 7-c are added to read as follows:

[Any] WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE LAND DESCRIBED IN SECTION SEVEN-A OF THIS ACT, ANY land and improvements thereon transferred pursuant to this act shall be used only by, or for the purposes of the state, the United States of America and its transferees or assigns, a municipal corporation or a not-for-profit college or university chartered by the

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regents of the university of the state of New York. Except for 1 the 2 United States of America and its transferees or assigns, said land and 3 any improvements thereon shall be used only for hospital, park and 4 recreation, municipal office or educational purposes, and for complemen-5 tary academic, scientific or technological uses, applied research and developmental activities of a not-for-profit college or university, 6 а 7 voluntary, municipal or state-operated hospital, or a municipal corporation. Said land or any improvements thereon transferred pursuant to 8 this act to the United States of America or its transferees or assigns 9 10 shall not be designed or altered for the overnight housing and/or custody of prisoners or detainees. These purposes and/or restrictions shall 11 recorded as deed covenants and restrictions running with the land 12 be upon the transfer of the land to the town of Islip, Suffolk county 13 and 14 its transferees or assigns. Provided, however, that the commissioner of 15 general services, subject to the approval of the town of Islip as evidenced by a resolution of the town board and upon payment of fair and 16 17 reasonable consideration as determined by said commissioner by New York Institute of Technology to the office of general services, shall amend, 18 19 modify or delete as set forth in said resolution any of the above stated 20 purposes, including the requirement that they be recorded as deed coven-21 ants and restrictions running with the land as such purposes and 22 restrictions may appear in a conveyance to the town of Islip, its trans-23 feree and assigns and apply to the following described five parcels of 24 land:

25 S 7-A. THE LANDS TO BE CONVEYED PURSUANT TO SECTION ONE-A OF THIS ACT 26 ARE SITUATED IN THE TOWN OF ISLIP, SUFFOLK COUNTY, AND ARE GENERALLY 27 DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

28 BEGINNING AT A POINT FORMED BY THE INTERSECTION OF THE WESTERLY SIDE 29 OF LOWELL AVENUE AND THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF EASTVIEW DRIVE; RUNNING THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE WESTERLY SIDE OF LOWELL AVENUE S07°39'38"E 30 300.00' TO A POINT; RUNNING THENCE WESTERLY TO THE EASTERLY SIDE 31 OF 32 EASTVIEW DRIVE S82°13'18"W 356.55' TO A POINT OF THE CURVATURE; RUNNING THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF EASTVIEW DRIVE ALONG THE ARC 33 OF BEARING TO THE RIGHT HAVING A RADIUS OF 455.93' AN ARC LENGTH 34 CURVE А 269.80' A CHORD DISTANCE OF 265.88 AND A CHORD BEARING OF N16°16'27"E TO 35 A POINT OF CURVATURE; RUNNING THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG THE EAST 36 SIDE OF 37 EASTVIEW DRIVE ALONG THE ARC OF A CURVE BEARING TO THE RIGHT HAVING A 38 RADIUS OF 166.89' AN ARC LENGTH OF 142.98' AND A CHORD BEARING OF 39 N57°46'04"E A CHORD DISTANCE OF 138.65' TO A POINT OF TANGENCY; RUNNING 40 THENCE EASTERLY ALONG THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF EASTVIEW DRIVE TO THEWESTERLY SIDE OF LOWELL AVENUE N82°18'41"E 122.59' TO THE POINT OR PLACE 41 42 OF BEGINNING.

43 S 7-B. RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED IN SECTION SEVEN OF THIS ACT SHALL NOT 44 APPLY TO THE PARCEL OF LAND DESCRIBED IN SECTION SEVEN-A OF THIS ACT.

45 S 7-C. THE TOWN OF ISLIP SHALL CONVEY THE LAND TRANSFERRED PURSUANT TO 46 SECTION ONE-A OF THIS ACT TO THE CENTRAL ISLIP FIRE DISTRICT. SUCH LAND 47 SHALL BE CONVEYED TO THE CENTRAL ISLIP FIRE DISTRICT FOR THE SOLE 48 PURPOSE OF THE CREATION OF A SUBSTATION.

49 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
