AN ACT directing the department of transportation to conduct a feasibility study on the expansion of high-occupancy vehicle lanes to connect interstate 278 to route 440 in Richmond county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. 1. The department of transportation is directed to conduct  
2     a feasibility study on the expansion of high-occupancy vehicle lanes in  
3     Richmond county, New York. Such study shall examine the possibility of  
4     whether high-occupancy vehicle lanes running east to west on interstate  
5     278 could be connected to high-occupancy vehicle lanes running north to  
6     south on route 440 in Richmond county.  
7     2. As used in this section, "high-occupancy vehicle" is defined as any  
8     automobile containing three or more people.  
9     S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
10    have become a law.
