AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to the collection of sales tax on abstracts of title and other public records searches

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision (c) of section 1105 of the tax law, as amended by chapter 583 of the laws of 2011, is amended to as follows:

- (1)furnishing of information by printed, mimeographed or multi-The graphed matter or by duplicating written or printed matter in any other including the services of collecting, compiling or analyzing information of any kind or nature and furnishing reports thereof to other persons, but excluding the furnishing of information which is personal or individual in nature and which is not or may not be substantially incorporated in reports furnished to other persons, and excluding the services of advertising or other agents, or other persons acting in representative capacity, and information services used by newspapers, electronic news services, radio broadcasters and television broadcasters in the collection and dissemination of news, and excluding meteorologiservices, AND EXCLUDING ABSTRACTS OF TITLE AND OTHER PUBLIC RECORDS SEARCHES SUCH AS TAX SEARCHES, SEARCHES FOR MUNICIPAL RECORDS CERTIFIED OR NONCERTIFIED COPIES OBTAINED FROM THE PUBLIC VIOLATIONS, RECORD, CERTIFICATES OF TITLE AND LIEN SEARCHES, CERTIFICATES OF STANDING AND FRANCHISE TAX SEARCHES, COOPERATIVE UNIT SEARCHES AND
- ZONING LOT PARTIES-IN-INTEREST CERTIFICATIONS. 21 S 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2014.
