AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the leasing of real  
property by boards of cooperative educational services

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subparagraph (a) of paragraph p of subdivision 4 of section  
2     1950 of the education law, as amended by chapter 602 of the laws of  
3     1994, is amended to read as follows:  
4     (a) To rent suitable land, classrooms, offices or buildings upon or in  
5     which to maintain and conduct such cooperative educational services and  
6     administrative offices for a period not to exceed [ten] TWENTY years and  
7     to improve, alter, equip and furnish such land, classrooms, offices or  
8     buildings in a suitable manner for such purposes (1) before executing  
9     any lease, the board shall adopt a resolution determining that such  
10    agreement is in the best financial interests of the supervisory district  
11    and stating the basis of that determination; (2) the rental payment  
12    shall not be more than the fair market value as determined by the board;  
13    and (3) upon the consent of the commissioner, renewal of such lease may  
14    be made for a period of up to ten years. Nothing contained herein shall  
15    prevent the board from entering into a lease agreement which provides  
16    for the cancellation of the same by such board upon: (i) a substantial  
17    increase or decrease in pupil enrollment; or (ii) a substantial change  
18    in the needs and requirements of a board of cooperative educational  
19    services with respect to facilities; or (iii) any other change which  
20    substantially affects the needs or requirements of a board of cooper-  
21    ative educational services or the community in which it is located. No  
22    lease or other contract for the occupancy of such land, classrooms,  
23    offices or buildings shall be enforceable against the board of cooper-  
24    ative educational services unless and until the same shall have been  
25    approved in writing by the commissioner.  
26    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
