AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to a program for the diagnosis and treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 7.17 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new subdivision (g) to read as follows:
- THE COMMISSIONER, IN COOPERATION WITH ANY OTHER STATE AGENCY OR RELEVANT STAKEHOLDER SHALL DEVELOP A TRAINING PROGRAM TO BE POSTED ON WEBSITE FOR THE DIAGNOSIS AND TREATMENT OF POST-TRAUMATIC THE OFFICE'S STRESS DISORDER FOR MILITARY **VETERANS**. THE PROGRAM SHALL INCLUDE A COMPONENT ON MILITARY CULTURE COMPETENCY AND SHALL BE INTENDED FOR THE MENTAL HEALTH AND MENTAL HEALTH TRAINING OF PROVIDERS CLINICIANS. 9 CERTIFICATION OF THE COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM MAY BE PROVIDED TO
- 10 PARTICIPANTS THROUGH THE OFFICE. S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
