AN ACT to establish an energy system tax stabilization reserve fund in the Lowville Central School District to lessen or prevent increases in the school district's real property tax levy

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Legislative findings. The legislature hereby finds that the 1 private development and ownership of wind energy systems located within 2 3 the Lowville Central School District may result in instability in the 4 real property tax base and the budgets of the district due to the uncer-5 tainty with the assessments of such wind energy systems at the time the 6 payments in lieu of taxes terminate. 7

S 2. Definitions. As used in this act:

8 (a) "Board of education" or "board" means the board of education of the Lowville Central School District. 9

(b) "Energy system tax stabilization reserve fund" or "fund" means the 10 energy system tax stabilization reserve fund established pursuant to 11 12 this act.

(c) "Payments in lieu of taxes" or "payments" means payments in lieu 13 of taxes receivable by the school district pursuant to contracts entered 14 15 into in accordance with section 487 of the real property tax law or subdivision 15 of section 858 of the general municipal law on any wind 16 17 energy system located wholly or partially within the Lowville Central School District. 18

19 (d) "School district" or "district" means the Lowville Central School 20 District.

21 (e) "Wind energy systems" shall be defined as in section 487 of the 22 real property tax law and shall include the land upon which the system

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1 is located, any equipment used in such generation, and equipment leading 2 from the system to the interconnection with the transmission system.

3 S 3. The board of education is hereby authorized to establish an ener-4 gy system tax stabilization reserve fund to lessen or prevent increases 5 in the school district's real property tax levy resulting from decreases 6 in revenue due to changes in the amount of or termination of payments in 7 lieu of taxes receivable by the school district provided, however, that 8 such fund shall be established unless approved by a majority vote of no 9 the qualified voters of the district present and voting on a separate 10 ballot proposition therefor at either a special district meeting which the board of education may call for such purposes, or at the annual 11 district meeting and election, to be noticed and conducted in either 12 13 case in accordance with the provisions of article 41 of the education 14 Further, the notice of the special district meeting or annual law. 15 district meeting and election, as applicable, at which such ballot 16 proposition shall be presented to the voters, shall explain the means by 17 which moneys shall be paid into and withdrawn from such fund as set 18 forth hereinafter in subdivisions (a) and (c) of this section. Moneys 19 shall be paid into and withdrawn from the fund, and the fund shall be 20 administered, as follows:

21 (a) For any school district fiscal year commencing after the effective 22 date of this act and after the establishment of the energy system tax 23 stabilization reserve fund, the board of education may determine that 24 there shall be paid into the fund all or any portion of the amount by 25 which the payments in lieu of taxes receivable by the school district 26 for such fiscal year is not required to prevent an increase in the school tax levy from the immediately preceding fiscal year, provided 27 28 that no payment into the reserve fund shall cause the balance of the fund to exceed the sum of twelve million dollars. Such determination may 29 be amended to reduce the amount paid into the fund in the event that the 30 district's original proposed budget is not approved by the voters. 31

32 (b) The board of education is hereby authorized to make a one-time 33 deposit into the energy system tax stabilization reserve fund in an 34 amount not to exceed the balance over any maximum allowable balance 35 authorized or required by any other law that accrued prior to the establishment of the energy system tax stabilization reserve fund as a result 36 37 of the receipt of any payment in lieu of taxes, provided, however, that 38 such deposit shall be made unless approved by a majority vote of the no 39 qualified voters of the district present and voting on a separate ballot 40 proposition therefor at either a special district meeting which the board of education may call for such purpose, or at the annual district 41 42 meeting and election, to be noticed and conducted in either case in accordance with the provisions of article 41 of the education law. 43 Further, the notice of the special district meeting or annual district 44 45 meeting and election, as applicable, at which such ballot proposition shall be presented to the voters, shall explain the means by which 46 47 moneys shall be paid into and withdrawn from such fund as set forth 48 hereinafter in subdivisions (a) and (c) of this section.

49 (c) Moneys may be withdrawn from the energy system tax stabilization 50 reserve fund subject to the following limitations:

51 (1) For any fiscal year for which payments in lieu of taxes receivable 52 by the school district equal or exceed the amount of such payments 53 received for the immediately preceding fiscal year, no amount shall be 54 withdrawn from the fund.

55 (2) For any fiscal year for which payments in lieu of taxes receivable 56 by the school district are less than the amount of such payments 1 received for the immediately preceding fiscal year, the board of educa-2 tion may authorize a withdrawal from the fund in an amount not to exceed 3 the amount of the payments received for the immediately preceding year 4 less the amount of the payments receivable for the fiscal year for which 5 the budget and tax levy is being determined.

6 (3) For any fiscal year for which the school district does not antic-7 ipate receiving any payments in lieu of taxes, the board of education 8 may authorize a withdrawal from the fund in an amount not to exceed the amount of such payments received for the last preceding fiscal year for 9 10 which such payments were received plus the amount, if any, which the 11 board of education authorized to be withdrawn from the fund for such last preceding fiscal year. 12

(4) Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this subdivision, and in addition 13 to any withdrawal from the fund authorized pursuant to paragraph 2 or 14 - 3 15 of this subdivision, moneys may be withdrawn from the fund for any fiscal year to be expended for any other lawful purpose, provided, 16 17 that no such withdrawal and expenditure shall be made unless however, approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters of the district 18 19 present and voting on a separate ballot proposition therefor at either a special district meeting which the board of education may call for such 20 21 purpose, or at the annual district meeting and election, to be noticed 22 and conducted in either case in accordance with the provisions of article 41 of the education law, such purposes as may be set forth in a 23 separate proposition submitted by the board of education and approved by 24 25 the qualified voters of the school district.

26 (d) Determinations by the board of education to pay money into the energy system tax stabilization reserve fund, authorizations by the board to withdraw money from the fund, and decisions by the board to 27 28 29 submit a ballot proposition to the voters authorizing a withdrawal from 30 fund shall be made on or before the last date provided by law for the submission to the state education department of the 31 the school 32 district's property tax report card pursuant to subdivision 7 of section 33 1716 of the education law.

(e) The moneys in the energy system tax stabilization reserve fund shall be deposited, invested and accounted for in the manner provided for in subdivisions 2 and 6 of section 3651 and section 3652 of the education law.

38 S 4. At the same time that the property tax report card prepared by school district pursuant to subdivision 7 of section 1716 of the 39 the 40 education law is filed and made publicly available, the school district shall also prepare, file with the commissioner of education and make publicly available in the same manner as required for the property tax 41 42 43 report card, a report which shall contain the following information 44 relating to the energy system tax stabilization reserve fund: (a) the 45 balance of the fund as of the start of the current fiscal year, (b) all deposits or withdrawals from the fund for the current fiscal year, 46 (C) 47 analysis of the impact of such withdrawals on the school district's an 48 tax levy for the current fiscal year, (d) proposed deposits and withdrawals for the ensuing fiscal year, and (e) an analysis of the impact 49 50 of such proposed deposits and withdrawals on the projected tax levy for 51 the ensuing fiscal year if the proposed budget is adopted.

52 S 5. When computing the school district's tax levy limit for a school 53 year pursuant to subdivision 3 of section 2023-a of the education law: 54 (a) The payments in lieu of taxes receivable for the prior school year

55 shall be decreased by any amount paid into the energy system tax

stabilization reserve fund for such prior school year and increased by 1 any amount withdrawn from the fund for such prior school year. 2

(b) The payments in lieu of taxes receivable in the coming fiscal year 3 4 shall be decreased by the amount to be paid into the energy system tax 5 stabilization reserve fund for such coming fiscal year and increased by 6 any amount to be withdrawn from the energy system tax stabilization 7 reserve fund for such coming fiscal year.

8 S 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision (c) of section three of this act and section four of this act, if this act shall take 9 10 effect later than fourteen days prior to the last date provided by law for the submission to the state education department of the school 11 district's property tax report card for the school district's ensuing 12 fiscal year, then a determination by the board of education to pay money 13 14 into the fund for the ensuing fiscal year may be made on or before the last date provided by law for the levy of taxes for such ensuing fiscal 15 year. Upon making such determination to pay money into the fund, the 16 board shall cause to be posted on the school district's website a state-17 ment containing the amount of the payment into the fund and the effect 18 19 of the payment on the projected tax levy for the ensuing fiscal year.

20 S 7. This act shall take effect immediately.
