- AN ACT to amend the public health law and the education law, in relation to authorizing schools to possess and administer epinephrine auto-injectors in emergency situations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 1 of section 3000-c of the 2 public health law, as amended by chapter 350 of the laws of 2001, is 3 amended to read as follows:

"Eligible person, firm, organization, or other entity" means, (i) 4 (a) 5 an ambulance service or advanced life support first response service; a б certified first responder, emergency medical technician, or advanced 7 emergency medical technician, who is employed by or an enrolled member 8 any such service; (ii) a children's overnight camp as defined in of 9 subdivision one of section thirteen hundred ninety-two of this chapter, 10 summer day camp as defined in subdivision two of section thirteen а 11 hundred ninety-two of this chapter, a traveling summer day camp as defined in subdivision three of section thirteen hundred ninety-two of 12 13 this chapter or a person employed by such a camp; or (iii) SCHOOL DISTRICTS, BOARDS OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, COUNTY VOCATIONAL 14 EDUCATION AND EXTENSION BOARDS, CHARTER SCHOOLS, AND NON-PUBLIC ELEMEN-15 TARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THIS STATE OR ANY PERSON EMPLOYED BY ANY 16 17 SUCH ENTITY; OR (IV) any other person, firm, organization or entity 18 designated pursuant to regulations of the commissioner in consultation

3 S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 921 to read 4 as follows:

5 921. ON-SITE EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTOR. 1. SCHOOL DISTRICTS, BOARDS S 6 OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, COUNTY VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND 7 EXTENSION BOARDS, CHARTER SCHOOLS, AND NON-PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECOND-IN THIS STATE MAY PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN ON-SITE IN EACH 8 ARY SCHOOLS 9 INSTRUCTIONAL SCHOOL FACILITY EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTORS IN OUANTITIES 10 TYPES DEEMED BY THE COMMISSIONER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COMMIS-AND SIONER OF HEALTH, TO BE ADEQUATE TO ENSURE READY AND APPROPRIATE 11 ACCESS DURING EMERGENCIES TO ANY STUDENT OR STAFF HAVING ANAPHYLACTIC 12 FOR USE SYMPTOMS WHETHER OR NOT THERE IS A PREVIOUS HISTORY OF 13 SEVERE ALLERGIC 14 REACTION.

15 2. SCHOOL DISTRICTS, BOARDS OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES, COUN-16 TY VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND EXTENSION BOARDS, CHARTER SCHOOLS, AND NON-17 PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THIS STATE OR ANY PERSON EMPLOYED BY ANY SUCH ENTITY MAY ADMINISTER EPINEPHRINE AUTO-INJECTORS IN 18 19 THEEVENT OF AN EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION THREE THOUSAND-C OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW. 20

S 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the commissioner of health, in consultation with the commissioner of education, may promulgate any rule or regulation necessary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date.
