AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system in the hamlet of West Babylon, county of Suffolk, as the "New York City Police Department Detective Peter Figoski Memorial Bridge"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 343-aa to read as follows:
 - S 343-AA. PORTION OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT DETECTIVE PETER FIGOSKI MEMORIAL BRIDGE". THE BRIDGE ON ROUTE 109 WHICH CROSSES THE SUNRISE HIGHWAY IN THE HAMLET OF WEST BABYLON, COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, SHALL BE DESIGNATED AND KNOWN AS THE "NEW YORK CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT DETECTIVE PETER FIGOSKI MEMORIAL BRIDGE".
- S 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act; provided that, to avoid any confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be changed as a result of this act.
