AN ACT in relation to reimbursing non-public schools and teachers for training

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, 1 2 the state shall reimburse non-public schools directly for the costs associated with two days of training for teachers to assist them in 3 preparing their students to meet the state's educational 4 standards. 5 Furthermore, the state shall directly reimburse non-public school teachб ers in an amount equal to the lesser of (i) the pro rata portion of 7 their salary that they are foregoing in order to obtain such training or 8 (ii) an amount equivalent to the pro rata share of the average salary of 9 public school teachers in the school districts in which the non-public 10 schools are located.

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
