AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to the treatment
of certain juveniles for certain prostitution offenses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new
2 section 170.80 to read as follows:
3 S 170.80 PROCEEDINGS REGARDING CERTAIN PROSTITUTION OFFENSES COMMITTED
4 BY JUVENILES.
5 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, WHEN A PERSON WHO IS
6 SIXTEEN OR SEVENTEEN YEARS OF AGE HAS BEEN ARRESTED FOR VIOLATING THE
7 PROVISIONS OF SECTION 230.00, 230.03 OR 240.37 OF THE PENAL LAW, ANY
8 JUDGE HEARING ANY ASPECT OF SUCH A CASE SHALL TREAT AND RETAIN THE CASE
9 AS A PERSON IN NEED OF SUPERVISION PROCEEDING FOR ALL PURPOSES AND SHALL
10 HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO GRANT ANY RELIEF AVAILABLE UNDER THE FAMILY COURT
11 ACT, AND ANY ADVERSE FINDING IN THE CASE SHALL BE AUTOMATICALLY EXPUNGED
12 UPON THE PERSON'S EIGHTEENTH BIRTHDAY.
13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to all
14 offenses committed on or after such effective date.
