AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to providing solar rights to homeowners

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 339-j of the real property law, as amended by chapter 437 of the laws of 1999, is amended to read as follows:

3 S 339-j. Compliance with by-laws and rules and regulations. 1. Each owner shall comply strictly with the by-laws and with rules, regu-4 unit 5 lations, resolutions and decisions adopted pursuant thereto. Failure to 6 comply with any of the same shall be ground for an action to recover sums due, for damages or injunctive relief or both maintainable by the 7 board of managers on behalf of the unit owners or, in a proper case, by 8 9 aggrieved unit owner. In any case of flagrant or repeated violation an by a unit owner, he OR SHE may be required by the board of managers to 10 give sufficient surety or sureties for his OR HER future compliance with 11 the by-laws, rules, regulations, resolutions and decisions. Notwith-12 standing the foregoing provisions of this section, no action or proceed-13 14 ing for any relief may be maintained due to the display of a flag of the United States measuring not more than four feet by six feet. 15

16 2. NO BOARD OF MANAGERS SHALL BAN IN THE BY-LAWS, ANY SOLAR PANEL 17 ARRAYS, THE INSTALLATION OF ROOFTOP SOLAR PANELS OR THE CLEARING AND TRIMMING OF VEGETATION ON UNIT OWNERS' PROPERTIES THAT OBSCURE 18 SUCH 19 SOLAR PANEL ARRAYS OR ROOFTOP SOLAR PANELS; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT THE 20 BOARD OF MANAGERS SHALL BE CONSULTED REGARDING THE AESTHETICS OF SUCH SOLAR PANEL ARRAYS AND ROOFTOP SOLAR PANELS. 21
