AN ACT to amend the energy law, in relation to consumer audio and video products energy efficiency standards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 16-106 of the energy law, as added by chapter 431 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows:

On or before [June thirtieth, two thousand six] JANUARY THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN, the secretary, in consultation with the president, shall adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions this article establishing: (i) energy efficiency performance standards for new products of the types set forth in paragraphs (a) (n) of subdivision one of section 16-104 of this article, with the exception of such [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (E) (CONSUMER AUDIO AND VIDEO PRODUCTS) AND (q) (incandescent reflector lamps); (ii) procedures for testing the energy efficiency of the products covered by paragraphs (a) 12 through (n) of subdivision one of section 16-104 of this article; (iii) 13 14 procedures for manufacturers to certify that products covered under this 15 article meet the energy efficiency standards to be promulgated under this article; and (iv) such further matters as are necessary to insure the proper implementation and enforcement of the provisions of WITH RESPECT TO CONSUMER AUDIO AND VIDEO PRODUCTS, THE SECREarticle. 19 TARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE PRESIDENT, SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY DETERMINE WHETHER AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE STANDARD FOR SUCH PRODUCTS SHOULD BE ESTABLISHED, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT FACTORS INCLUDING BUT NOT 22 LIMITED TO, THE POTENTIAL IMPACT ON ELECTRICITY USAGE, PRODUCT AVAIL-23 ABILITY, MANUFACTURING COST, INNOVATION, PRODUCT CONVERGENCE, FEATURES AND FUNCTION, AND CONSUMER AND ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS. BASED ON 24 RECOMMENDATIONS OF SUCH STUDY, THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE PRESIDENT, MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH 26 THE27 ESTABLISHING ENERGY PERFORMANCE THIS ARTICLE STANDARDS FOR SUCH PRODUCTS ON OR BEFORE JANUARY THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN.

respect to incandescent reflector lamps, included in paragraph (g) of subdivision one of section 16-104 of this article, the secretary, shall conduct a study to determine consultation with the president, whether an energy efficiency performance standard for such product 5 should be established, taking into account factors including the potenimpact on electricity usage, product availability and consumer and 6 environmental benefits. If it is determined based on this study that 7 8 such a standard would reduce energy use and would not be preempted by 9 the federal law, the secretary, in consultation with the president, 10 shall adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions of this article establishing energy performance standards for such product on or 11 before January first, two thousand eight. 12 13

S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that no energy efficiency performance standard shall become effective for a product less than one hundred eighty days after such energy efficiency performance standard shall become final.
