AN ACT to amend the energy law, in relation to consumer audio and video products energy efficiency standards

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 16-106 of the 2 energy law, as added by chapter 431 of the laws of 2005, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 (a) On or before [June thirtieth, two thousand six] JANUARY 5 THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN, the secretary, in consultation with 6 the president, shall adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions 7 this article establishing: (i) energy efficiency performance standof 8 ards for new products of the types set forth in paragraphs (a) through 9 (n) of subdivision one of section 16-104 of this article, with the 10 exception of such [paragraph] PARAGRAPHS (E) (CONSUMER AUDIO AND VIDEO PRODUCTS) AND (q) (incandescent reflector lamps); (ii) procedures for 11 testing the energy efficiency of the products covered by paragraphs (a) 12 through (n) of subdivision one of section 16-104 of this article; (iii) 13 14 procedures for manufacturers to certify that products covered under this 15 article meet the energy efficiency standards to be promulgated under 16 this article; and (iv) such further matters as are necessary to insure 17 the proper implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this WITH RESPECT TO CONSUMER AUDIO AND VIDEO PRODUCTS, THE SECRE-18 article. 19 TARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE PRESIDENT, SHALL CONDUCT A STUDY TΟ 20 DETERMINE WHETHER AN ENERGY PERFORMANCE STANDARD FOR SUCH PRODUCTS SHOULD BE ESTABLISHED, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT FACTORS 21 INCLUDING BUT NOT 22 LIMITED TO, THE POTENTIAL IMPACT ON ELECTRICITY USAGE, PRODUCT AVAIL-23 ABILITY, MANUFACTURING COST, INNOVATION, PRODUCT CONVERGENCE, PRODUCT FEATURES AND FUNCTION, AND CONSUMER AND ENVIRONMENTAL BENEFITS. BASED ON 24 25 RECOMMENDATIONS OF SUCH STUDY, THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE THE PRESIDENT, MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH 26 THEPROVISIONS 27 ESTABLISHING ENERGY PERFORMANCE OF THIS ARTICLE STANDARDS FOR SUCH PRODUCTS ON OR BEFORE JANUARY THIRTY-FIRST, TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN. 28 With

respect to incandescent reflector lamps, included in paragraph (g) of 1 subdivision one of section 16-104 of this article, the secretary, 2 in shall conduct a study to determine 3 consultation with the president, 4 whether an energy efficiency performance standard for such product 5 should be established, taking into account factors including the potenimpact on electricity usage, product availability and consumer and б tial environmental benefits. If it is determined based on this study that 7 8 such a standard would reduce energy use and would not be preempted by 9 the federal law, the secretary, in consultation with the president, 10 shall adopt regulations in accordance with the provisions of this article establishing energy performance standards for such product on or 11 before January first, two thousand eight. 12

13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 14 no energy efficiency performance standard shall become effective for a 15 product less than one hundred eighty days after such energy efficiency 16 performance standard shall become final.
