AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to proof of identity requirements for the issuance of a driver's license

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 502-b to read as follows:

3 S 502-B. PROOF OF IDENTITY; CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS PROGRAM. 1. NOTWITH-4 STANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE 5 WHO PROVIDES SATISFACTORY PROOF THAT HIS OR HER PRESENCE IN THE UNITED 6 STATES IS AUTHORIZED UNDER FEDERAL LAW, BUT WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A 7 SOCIAL SECURITY ACCOUNT NUMBER, IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE AN ORIGINAL DRIV-8 ER'S LICENSE IF HE OR SHE MEETS ALL OTHER QUALIFICATIONS FOR LICENSURE.

9 2. ANY FEDERAL DOCUMENT DEMONSTRATING FAVORABLE ACTION BY THE FEDERAL 10 GOVERNMENT FOR ACCEPTANCE OF A PERSON INTO THE DEFERRED ACTION FOR 11 CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS PROGRAM SHALL SATISFY THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS OF 12 SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION WITH RESPECT TO PROOF OF IDENTITY.

13 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 14 have become a law.
