AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to requiring that  
the New York city housing authority include a notice informing a  
prospective tenant or tenant of the ability to add legal occupants to  
the lease or renewal lease, and provide, upon request, a tenant with a  
form to add additional legal occupants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-  
BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Subdivisions 7, 8 and 9 of section 402 of the public hous-  
2     ing law are relettered subdivisions 8, 9 and 10 and a new subdivision 7  
3     is added to read as follows:  
4     7. A. THE NEW YORK CITY HOUSING AUTHORITY SHALL INCLUDE, ALONG WITH  
5     EVERY LEASE OR RENEWAL LEASE OFFERED TO A PROSPECTIVE TENANT OR CURRENT  
6     TENANT, A SEPARATE, CLEAR AND CONSPICUOUS NOTICE, IN AT LEAST  
7     SIXTEEN-POINT BOLDFACE TYPE, CONCERNING THE TENANT'S ABILITY TO ADD  
8     ADDITIONAL LEGAL OCCUPANTS TO THE LEASE AGREEMENT.  
9     B. UPON RECEIPT OF A TENANT'S REQUEST FOR A FORM TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL  
10    LEGAL OCCUPANT, THE AUTHORITY SHALL, WITHIN SEVEN DAYS, PROVIDE THE  
11    TENANT WITH THE APPROPRIATE FORM, ALONG WITH A NOTICE INFORMING THE  
12    TENANT OF THE RIGHT TO CONTEST THE DENIAL OF ANY OCCUPANCY PERMISSION  
13    REQUEST.  
14    S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
15    have become a law.
