AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to prohibiting mandatory influenza vaccinations as a condition for employment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section  
2     399-ff to read as follows:  
3     S 399-FF. PROHIBITION OF MANDATORY INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS. NO EMPLOYER  
4     SHALL REQUIRE INFLUENZA VACCINATIONS AS A CONDITION OF EMPLOYMENT. THIS  
5     SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO EMPLOYEES OF LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES PURSU-  
6     ANT TO SECTION TWENTY-ONE HUNDRED NINETY-FOUR OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH LAW.  
7     S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
