AN ACT to amend the estates, powers and trusts law, in relation to the power of the fiduciary to access electronic mail and electronic information storage accounts

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The estates, powers and trusts law is amended by adding a new section 11-1.12 to read as follows:

S 11-1.12 POWER OF THE FIDUCIARY TO ACCESS ELECTRONIC MAIL AND ELECTRON-IC INFORMATION STORAGE ACCOUNTS

- (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE EXECUTOR OR ADMIN-ISTRATOR OF THE ESTATE OF A DECEASED PERSON WHO WAS DOMICILED STATE AT THE TIME OF HIS OR HER DEATH IS AUTHORIZED TO REQUEST ACCESS TO OR COPIES OF THE CONTENTS OF THE DECEDENT'S ELECTRONIC MAIL ACCOUNTS AND STORAGE ACCOUNTS FOR THE PURPOSES OF (1) ACCESSING THE INFORMATION ELECTRONIC MAIL AND INFORMATION STORED IN SUCH ACCOUNTS; AND (2) CLOSING SUCH ACCOUNTS; PROVIDED THAT SUCH ACCOUNTS SHALL BE CLOSED WITHIN ACCESS TO SUCH ACCOUNTS IS GRANTED OR COPIES OF THE THE DATE DAYS OF CONTENTS OF SUCH ACCOUNTS ARE PROVIDED TO THE EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR; AND PROVIDED FURTHER THAT AN EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR WHO ACCESS TO SUCH ACCOUNTS SHALL USE THE ACCOUNTS TO DOWNLOAD THE INFORMA-TION CONTAINED IN SUCH ACCOUNTS AND TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO THIRD THAT THE ACCOUNT HOLDER IS DECEASED.
- (B) AN ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER OR INFORMATION STORAGE SERVICE PROVIDER WHO HAS RECEIVED FROM THE EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR OF THE ESTATE OF A DECEASED PERSON WHO WAS DOMICILED IN THIS STATE AT THE TIME OF HIS OR HER DEATH A REQUEST FOR ACCESS TO OR COPIES OF THE CONTENTS OF THE DECEDENT'S ACCOUNT ACCOMPANIED BY EITHER (1) A WRITTEN REQUEST FOR ACCESS OR COPIES MADE BY SUCH EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR, ACCOMPANIED BY A COPY OF THE DEATH CERTIFICATE AND A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE CERTIFICATE OF APPOINTMENT AS EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR; OR (2) AN ORDER OF THE COURT HAVING JURISDICTION OF THE ESTATE OF SUCH DECEASED PERSON ORDERING

ACCESS OR COPIES OF THE ACCOUNT INFORMATION SHALL GRANT SUCH ACCESS OR PROVIDE SUCH COPIES WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF SUCH REQUEST.

- (C) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE FOLLOWING TERMS SHALL MEAN:
- "ELECTRONIC MAIL ACCOUNT" MEANS: (A) ALL ELECTRONIC MAIL SENT OR RECEIVED BY AN END-USER OF ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICES PROVIDED BY AN ELEC-TRONIC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER THAT IS STORED OR RECORDED BY SUCH ELEC-TRONIC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES; AND (B) ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC INFORMATION STORED OR RECORDED BY SUCH ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER THAT IS DIRECTLY RELATED TO THE ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICES PROVIDED TO SUCH END-USER BY SUCH ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, BILLING AND PAYMENT INFORMATION.
 - "ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO (A) IS AN INTERMEDIARY IN SENDING OR RECEIVING ELECTRONIC MAIL, AND (B) PROVIDES TO END-USERS OF ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICES THE ABILITY TO SEND OR RECEIVE ELECTRONIC MAIL.
- (3) "INFORMATION STORAGE ACCOUNT" MEANS ANY ACCOUNT HELD IN THE DECEDENT'S NAME THAT WAS USED TO ELECTRONICALLY STORE DOCUMENTS, 19 PICTURES, INFORMATION, AND ELECTRONIC FILES, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER DOCUMENTS, PICTURES, INFORMATION AND ELECTRONIC FILES WERE STORED BY THE 20 DECEDENT.
 - "INFORMATION STORAGE SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO (4)PROVIDES USERS WITH THE ABILITY TO STORE DOCUMENTS, PICTURES, INFORMA-TION, AND ELECTRONIC FILES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO CLOUD STORAGE, SOCIAL NETWORKING WEBSITES, AND PHOTO SHARING WEBSITES.
 - (D) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO REOUIRE AN ELECTRON-IC MAIL SERVICE PROVIDER OR INFORMATION STORAGE SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO ANY ACCOUNT OR TO DISCLOSE ANY INFORMATION:
 - (1) IN VIOLATION OF ANY APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAW; OR
- (2) TO WHICH THE DECEASED PERSON WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN PERMITTED ACCESS 30 IN THE ORDINARY COURSE OF BUSINESS BY THE ELECTRONIC MAIL SERVICE 31 32 PROVIDER OR INFORMATION STORAGE SERVICE PROVIDER.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 33
