AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to making violations of provisions of law relating to the care of animals by pet dealers a misdemeanor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 406 of the agriculture and markets 2 law, as amended by chapter 251 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read 3 as follows:
- 2. Violation of any provision of this article[,] is a [civil offense, for which a penalty of not less than one hundred dollars and not more than one thousand dollars for each violation may be imposed] MISDEMEANOR.
- 8 S 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 9 have become a law.
