AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to requiring the state uniform fire prevention and building code to include provisions mandating that buildings used for commercial purposes have installed such operable carbon monoxide detectors as shall be necessary

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 378 of the executive law is amended by adding a new subdivision 5-d to read as follows:
- 5-D. STANDARDS FOR INSTALLATION OF CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS REQUIRING ALL BUILDINGS USED FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES TO HAVE INSTALLED OPERABLE CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS OF SUCH MANUFACTURE, DESIGN, INSTALLATION STANDARDS AND IN SUCH QUANTITY AS ARE ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNCIL.
- S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
