AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to prohibiting the dissemination of any image of a person to an obscene internet website, without such person's knowledge or consent

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 250.55 of the penal law, as added by chapter 69 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:

S 250.55 Dissemination of an unlawful surveillance image in the second degree.

A person is guilty of dissemination of an unlawful surveillance image in the second degree when [he]:

- 1. HE or she, with knowledge of the unlawful conduct by which an image or images of the sexual or other intimate parts of another person or persons were obtained and such unlawful conduct would satisfy the essential elements of the crime of unlawful surveillance in the first or second degree, intentionally disseminates such image or images[.]; OR
- 2. WITHOUT THE KNOWLEDGE OR CONSENT OF ANOTHER PERSON, HE OR SHE IS DISSEMINATES AN IMAGE OF THAT PERSON WHICH HE OR SHE KNOWS IS OBSCENE, TO A COMPUTER NETWORK INTERNET WEBSITE. FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS SECTION, IS "OBSCENE" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS IT IS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION 235.00 OF THIS PART.
- Dissemination of an unlawful surveillance image in the second degree is a class A misdemeanor.
- 19 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-20 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
