AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting the city of New York from increasing property taxes where a property's assessed value has decreased in the previous year

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended 2 by adding a new section 11-239-a to read as follows:
- 3 S 11-239-A ASSESSMENTS FOLLOWING DECREASED VALUATION. THE ASSESSED 4 VALUE OF REAL PROPERTY SHALL NOT BE INCREASED FOR THE PERIOD OF A YEAR 5 AFTER SUCH PROPERTY'S ASSESSED VALUE HAS DECREASED.
- 6 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
