AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to including the Hoosic River in the definition of "inland waterways" for the purposes of waterfront revitalization

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 4 of section 911 of the executive law, as separately amended by chapters 32 and 133 of the laws of 3 2012, is amended to read as follows:
- (b) the state's major rivers comprised of the Allegheny, Ausable, Black, Boquet, Canisteo, Chaumont (including Chaumont bay), Chemung, Cohocton, Delaware, Deer, Genesee, Grasse, HOOSIC, Hudson north of the federal dam at Troy, Indian, Little (in the Adirondack park), Little Salmon (including north and south branches), Mad, Mettowee, Mohawk, Oswegatchie Racquette Sacandaga Salmon Saranac Susquehanna Tioga
- 9 Oswegatchie, Racquette, Sacandaga, Salmon, Saranac, Susquehanna, Tioga, 10 Tioughnioga, Wallkill and Buffalo rivers, and the north and middle
- 11 branches of the Moose river;
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
