AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to the prohibition of animal fighting

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 351 of the agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new paragraph (f) to read as follows:
- 3 (F) KNOWINGLY CAUSES A MINOR TO ATTEND ANY PLACE WHERE AN EXHIBITION 4 OF ANIMAL FIGHTING IS BEING CONDUCTED. THE TERM "MINOR" MEANS A PERSON 5 UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN YEARS OLD.
- 6 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
